Emergency / Fire Safety Information for Guests of Hotel Mutterhaus Düsseldorf

Dear Hotel Mutterhaus Düsseldorf Guests!

We want to make your stay in our hotel as safe as possible. For this purpose, the hotel is equipped with an **automatic fire alarm system**, among other things. In the event of a fire in the building, the fire department will be notified automatically as soon as the fire breaks out. In case of a fire, a loud, constant beep will sound in all of the corridors and conference rooms as a signal for a fire alarm.

If you detect a fire you can also notify the fire department yourself by dialling the telephone number **0-112 fire brigade** or by using one of the **manual call points** throughout the building (in the stairwells or in front of the metal emergency staircase in the hallway).

If an alarm should occur during your stay with us, for your own safety we would like to request that you leave the building immediately via the corridors and the stairwell closest to you. These **escape routes** are marked with **green escape route pictograms**. Warn people at risk, take helpless people with you, close doors (but not lock) and if possible close windows. Only attempt to extinguish the fire if you can do so without endangering yourself!

Please go directly to the **assembly point** outdoors designated for the Hotel Mutterhaus Düsseldorf. There you will be registered by our employees in order to determine whether everyone was able to leave the building. Please do not leave the assembly point until instructed to do so by the fire department or the employees of our hotel. The assembly point is located on the right hand side as seen from the perspective of looking towards the hotel from the roundabout in front of the main entrance.

Internet
